Why is the project needed? <b>The residents of Curnock Street Estate are desperate for new security measures to be put in place to prevent/reduce drug dealing, crime and antisocial behaviour. At several TRA general meetings over the last few years, numerous residents have reported that they witnessed crimes on the estate, have been physically threatened/attacked and generally feel unsafe for themselves, their families and their neighbours. The residents have asked the</b>	

<p><b>TRA committee, Community Safety Officer (Natasha Dickinson) and the police (Dean Kirby) to take action. The police have stated that the open plan nature of the estate makes it's difficult to catch the dealers and other criminals. In order to combat this problem, the proposed fencing and gates will serve to block main escape routes through the estate. We are aware that similar fencing/gate was previously installed on another estate and that it was highly effective in reducing criminal activity.</b></p>
